Asist. Prof. Dr. Elvan Erkmen was born in 1959 in İstanbul. She graduated from İstanbul German High School in 1978 and completed her graduate studies in İstanbul Fine Arts Academy in 1983. She wrote anthologies about people and movements in art and architecture history between 1984 and 1985.

She started working as a Research Assistant in the Department of Architecture History in Mimar Sinan University in 1985. She received her PhD degree with her PhD thesis entitled "Clemens Holzmeister and his place in Turkish Architecture". (This thesis is still being exhibited at Salzburg Clemens Holzmeister Museum's publications section) She became an Assistant Professor in 1999.

She submitted papers to various national and international symposiums and took responsibility at important exhibition organizations. As well as having national and international journals being published, she attended such symposium organizations as; "Architecture, Media, Arts Symposium" within the scope of 1st International Architecture-Art Symposium; November 2010 Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University Symposium (with Architecture Department); "Contemporary Art and Architecture Seminar in the 85th year of the Republic of Turkey"; October 2008 Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University Symposium (with Architecture Department), 1st International Architecture Theory Symposium ARCHTEO-2011, November 2011, (with Efe Duyan) and submitted papers to Green Age symposium series.

She owns 2 architectural awards; one was won while she was a student.
