Emine B. Tusavul completed her high school education at American Academy For Girls in Istanbul, in 1979. She continued her education in the Department of Graphic Design at the Faculty of Graphic Design in Mimar Sinan University and graduated with a BS degree from Skidmore College, USA in 1983 . She carried on with her studies on printmaking in the same College for another year. Upon her return to Turkey, she worked for two companies as an art director and an advertising manager from 1984 to 1991. She acted as the founding partner of T.T Advertising between 1991 and 1997 and 'Bir E Bir' Advertising from 1997 to present. Tusavul conducted a photography project with the students of Istanbul Technical University – Architecture Department, which finalized in a set of ten books focusing on the graphic language of Istanbul at the beginning of the millennium. She has artworks in the collections of the Skidmore College and IMOGA. She became a member of the Board of Directors at the Advertising Association between 1999 and 2006 and has received many awards from the Graphic Designers Guild in Istanbul. Tusavul is also the creator of the Kagithane – Houseofpaper, a brand designing, producing and selling mainly trendy printed-paper products. She is now continuing The Art Theory and Criticism Graduate Program in İşık University, where she has also been a lecturer in the Visual Communication Design Department at the Faculty of Fine Arts since 2007.
