Born in Istanbul (1966). Completed her middle education at Atakoy High School (1983). Finished Yildiz Technical University Architecture major (1987). Completed her master degree at the Faculty of Architecture of Yildiz Technical University Applied Sciences Institute Survey and Restoration Main Science Division by submitting her thesis "Adaptation of Turkish House to the Modern Life" (1990).

She kept working at prestigious architecture firms until 1994 since 1987.

She began working at the Architectural Restoration program at the Vocational School of Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University in 1994. With her doctorate thesis titled as "Experimental Method Research on Performance of Natural Stone Material Protectors", she completed her doctorate studies at the Science Division of Structural Physics and Material at Applied Sciences Institute of the Faculty of Architecture in Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University (2002). She developed "Protective Test Performance Device" in order to research the effects of chemical and environmental factors and protection of Stone-like materials used in historical buildings while she was working on her doctorate thesis. This device is functioning as a weathering simulation on protection of all materials. She earned a mention award from the National Invention Competition and a Scientific Success Award from the Rectorship of Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University for the device she invented.
