

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR SFL ELECTIVE FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROGRAMME STUDENTS

1. Do I have to choose an ELP course?

ELP Courses are optional. You can take a foreign language course at any time during your studies.

2. May I change the foreign language that I chose?

Yes you can. You can do it during the add-drop week or take another course the following semester, if you fail.

3. What level can I achieve at the end of the program?

There are two courses: 1101 and 1102, at the end of which you will be able to achieve the A1 level of CEFR (The Common European Framework of Reference.)

4. Is attendance mandatory?

Attendance is mandatory for all Foreign Language courses (%70)
