

Frequently Asked Questions for ING Courses

- **Do I have to choose ING101 and ING102 courses?**

Yes. ING 101 and ING102 courses are compulsory. However students sit “the placement test” at the beginning of the academic year. If a student gets 30 and above, s/he can be exempted from ING101, if s/he gets 45 and above s/he can be exempted from ING102.

- **May I drop an ING course?**

No. You have to take the courses of the first academic year.

- **What level can I achieve at the end of the ING program?**

This course brings students from A1 to A2 level and brings them half way through the A2 level.

- **Is the attendance mandatory?**

Yes. Students have to attend minimum 80 % of the courses. Otherwise they fail.

- **What is the evaluation criterion?**

See the table below for the evaluation criteria?

- **Where can I find out about exam dates and subjects?**

Exam dates and subject are written on the syllabus which is distributed during the first week of the term. The syllabus is also posted online on course-online.

- **Do I need to purchase books?**

Yes.

- **I need to speak to my English instructor; do they have office hours when I can visit them?**

Each and every instructor has a 2-hour-long office hour. Office hour schedule is posted on the instructors' office doors.
