**Detailed Information About the Program:** Blended Intensive Programs (BIP) are short, intensive training programs using innovative teaching and learning methods, including online collaboration. Students and staff participating in the program will receive blended training both face-to-face and online.

Other Partner Universities; Universita Degli Studi Mediterranea Di Reggio Calabria (Italy) and Instituto Politecnico De Viana De Castelo (Portugal)

**Quotas:** 5 students will be selected for the activity to be organized by the Faculty of Art, Design and Architecture to participate in the mobility within the framework of the Mixed Intensive Program (BIP) in the 2022 Erasmus+ KA131 project period.

- The physical mobility part of the BIP will take place on 6-12 May in "Universita Degli Studi Mediterranea Di Reggio Calabria, Italy".
- Participation in the online courses in April 2024 will be compulsory.
- The applicant student must have a course load of at least 3 ECTS.

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS WHO WILL APPLY TO THE PROGRAM:

- To be a 2nd, 3rd or 4th year student at Işık University Faculty of Art, Design and Architecture,
- The student's GPA must be at least 2.20/4.00,
- Işık Exit result or Equivalent Exams (PTE Academic, KPDS, YDS, ÜDS, TOEFL)
  - (Exam results are valid for 4 years. Exam results on or after February 2020 will be accepted. The minimum language score required to participate in the Erasmus+ Program is 70. The applications of students who do not meet the 70 point requirement at the time of application will be invalidated. (The applications of students who do not have an oral grade in the Exit exam will also be invalidated.)
- As the physical mobility will take place in May 2024, only applications from students with valid visas or green passports will be accepted.





### **ERASMUS SCORE CALCULATION METHOD:**

Erasmus Score = 50% GPA (out of 100) + 50% Foreign Language Score (out of 100)

#### **APPLICATION DOCUMENTS:**

- 1. Exit Exam Result Certificate You can get it from the School of Foreign Languages SFL before the application. (When requesting a document, you must specify that you are requesting it for the Erasmus+ mobility application).
- 2. Transcript (e-signed official current transcript from E-Campus)

NOTE: Documents will not be exchanged after the application deadline.

#### WHERE WILL BIP APPLICATIONS BE RECEIVED?

Students who want to participate in the program are required to make their applications by logging in with their Turkish ID No. and E-Government password through the <u>TURNAPortal</u> system.

#### **FINANCIAL SUPPORT:**

Within the scope of BIP, individual support of €70 per day will be provided to students who will realize mobility. Each student who will participate in the activity will be paid a total grant of € 490 for the 7-day activity within the scope of the 2022 Project Year Erasmus+ project. No travel grant will be paid to the selected students apart from the individual support.

### **GREEN TRAVEL:**

Green travel is the use of public transportation with low carbon emissions. The use of buses, trains and shared cars are included in the scope of green travel. In order to receive green travel support, green travel must be used on the way to and on the way back and more than half of the entire trip in terms of km must be made using green vehicles.

#### **INCLUSION SUPPORT:**

The Erasmus+ Programme encourages the participation of people with special needs. A person with special needs is a potential participant whose personal physical, mental or health condition does not allow them to participate in the project/mobility activity without additional financial support. In order to award extra grants to students and staff requiring special needs support, the beneficiary higher education institution must request an additional grant from the Center. After the participant with special needs support is selected, if the participant has an additional grant request, the approximate additional costs are determined and an additional grant is requested from the Center.
