

Frequently Asked Questions

How many guests can I bring?

Each graduate may bring **two guests only**. Due to the limited capacity of the ceremony venue, we aim to provide equal opportunity for all graduates to be accompanied by guests. Thank you for your understanding.

Will guests be charged a fee?

No, there is no fee for guests. However, we kindly ask all graduates to adhere to the guest limit.

Will gowns be distributed on the day of the ceremony (May 24–25)?

No.

Until when can I collect my cap and gown?

Cap and gown distribution will end at **4:30 PM on May 16, 2025**.

Can someone else collect my gown on my behalf?

Yes, **if the payment receipt is issued in your name**, a friend or family member can collect your gown and cap on your behalf.

To whom/where should I submit my payment receipt?

You must submit your receipt, which must be issued in your name, to the staff at the distribution area when collecting your gown. Graduates who fail to present a receipt will not be able to collect their gowns.

What do I need to do to be eligible to participate in the ceremony?

You must complete your **cap and gown payment** by **May 9, 2025**.
